#### **OVERVIEW:**

The Inn at Pocono Resort blends a century of hospitality with the demands of 21<sup>st</sup> Century travelers. Lovingly referred to as the “The Grand Lady of the Mountains” and a National Registry of Historic Places property, The Inn at Pocono Manor opened in 1902 as a country retreat for Philadelphia Quakers. Today it is the oldest continuously operating resort in the Poconos and one of the oldest in North America.

A destination within the Poconos for over 100 years, the 3000-acre Inn at Pocono Manor is within two hours of New York City, New Jersey and Philadelphia.

- OPENING DATE:** 1902
- LOCATION:** One Manor Drive in Pocono Manor, Pennsylvania, near the intersection of I-380 & Route 314, two miles from I-80.
- CULINARY OPTIONS:** **The Exchange at Pocono Manor** restaurant features superb dining for dinner with an eclectic flair.
- The Old Lamplighter Lounge** serves specialty beverages and pub fare throughout the day and evening.
- Mountain View Dining Room** serves three meals daily. Dinner includes a pre fix four-course menu. Holiday feasts include Thanksgiving & Mothers Day.
- AMENITIES:** The Inn at Pocono Manor is a full service resort, featuring 237 spacious guestrooms, complimentary hi-speed wireless connectivity, complimentary daily newspapers, and coffee service in lobby. Seasonal children's/family activities and concierge services available.
- RECREATION/SPORTS:** The resort's beautiful 3000 acres include walking paths, bicycling, indoor and outdoor pools, waterfalls, horseback riding, BB Range, Archery, 5 Stand, Fishing, Golf Cart Tours and more. Winter activities include dog-sledding, snowshoeing, cross country skiing and snowmobiling. Downhill skiing and boarding are available nearby at Camelback Mountain.
- GOLF:** Our two 18-hole courses have been challenging many of golf's greats for decades. Our **East Course**, which opened in 1912, was redesigned by Donald Ross in 1927 and offers challenging water hazards and breathtaking views. Our **West Course**, which opened in 1965, was designed by George Fazio. This course favors the long ball hitter who enjoys a wide fairway. Other golf services include a Pro Shop, Lessons, Driving Range and Restaurant & Bar.
